- ideas for **internal online volunteering** services (providing direct services for the organisations)

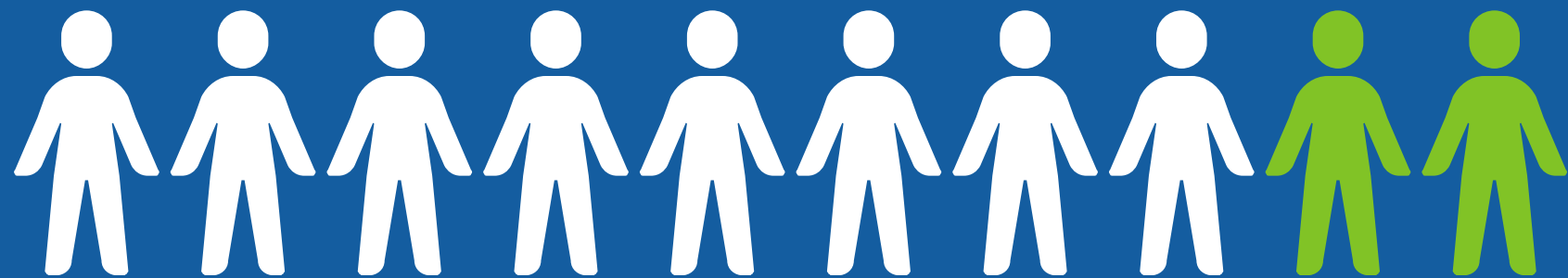

# EDUCATION AND TRAINING

Online courses and workshops – if you have technical skills (programming, graphic design, etc.) or a passion that you think could be useful to others (yoga, dance, painting, guitar, etc.) organise online events to teach and inspire others.



**Educator/teacher** – if you feel comfortable teaching/training virtually anything (biology, math or other subjects) contact organisations that might need good teachers for their beneficiaries to organise or facilitate online classes.

# EDUCATION AND TRAINING

**Accessibility of materials** – you can adapt different resources (articles, books, podcasts, etc) either audio or written, for people who are visually or hearing impaired, making them available to them.

**Design for education** – if you have graphic design skills, you can create educational materials or visual campaigns that go hand in hand with the mission of the organisation you want to support.

**On line tutoring** – it is when someone (tutor) provides extra support, or help in a subject area to another person to help them improve. It can be in the form of one-on-one help, small group sessions, or even help in a subject area through videos or online tutorials.

# COUNSELLING AND COACHING



## Online coaching

for different target groups– you can offer your specific skills to coach people on their specific needs.



## Specific expert counselling services

you can offer expert counselling services like legal counselling or financial advices for people in need– e.g. refugees.



## Online volunteer management

if you have coordination skills and experience, put it to work for organisations working with volunteers or in different projects.



## Online volunteer mentoring or management

if you like to listen and interact with people, you could take the time to talk to local volunteers of organisations or international volunteers, offering them support and quality conversations.

# OTHER ONLINE VOLUNTEERING ACTIVITIES

## Handwork/ Crafts

if you have crafting skills, you can organise courses or workshops at home to teach the beneficiaries of an organisation how to develop these skills online.

## Synchronous cooking sessions

you can issue an invitation to cooking sessions in which you and other participants assess each other's recipe preferences, ingredients, and cook at the same time, each from their own kitchen, with the results presented online.

## Sports sessions

if you are passionate about sports activities, you can create a pathway of activities suitable for different age groups and support them through online communication channels.

## Music sessions

if you have a passion for music, you can use Youtube tutorials to create percussion(music) sessions using body parts. You can invite your friends to join you virtually, and together you can delight in creating a song.

# OTHER ONLINE VOLUNTEERING ACTIVITIES



## Online party planner

if your musical tastes are always complimented and you have DJ skills, an alternative would be to organize online parties for the beneficiaries of organizations.



## Poetry sessions

you can organise online slam poetry sessions, using gradually increasing difficulty. You can start by creating two rhyming lines to some extent, 4 lines, then 12 – until you have a poem.



## Phone or online friend

if you have the time, patience and empathy – make yourself available to those who need to talk to someone about their life, their struggles and joys – you don't have to be a therapist to give someone a listening session and a kind word now and then.



## Organise a book club

if you love reading and want to share your reading with others by giving them the chance to do the same, you can organize a virtual books club.

# OTHER ONLINE VOLUNTEERING ACTIVITIES



## Support group sessions

if you like bringing people together, you can facilitate virtual meetings where participants support each other, fulfilling their basic need to communicate.



## Psychological/therapeutic support

put your skills to work by counselling volunteers or benefactors when there is a specific need or when the organization is going through a period of uncertainty.



## Read the news

using a dating platform such as Zoom, GoogleMeet or other virtual communication channels (WhatsUp, Messenger, etc) you can read news for seniors or people who are visually impaired. Choose only official sources and don't hesitate to sneak positive news in.



## Read stories

if you like reading, you can register or use online communication channels to organise sessions where you can read and even act out stories for children of all ages.

## Write letters

if you like to design and send encouraging messages, you can write letters to the lonely, the elderly, forgotten grandparents, volunteers or isolated people.



## A creative –Thank you!

several friends can create a funny or inspirational video to thank or celebrate different types of people: firefighters, doctors, volunteers, teachers or perhaps a member of the community who has achieved something special.



## Memories collector

you can create a collection of stories about times long gone – about the war period, the pandemic, how our grandparents spent their free time, etc. You can collect them all with the pleasure of a documentarian and then turn it into an electronic publication.

If you like a challenge and want to help an organisation access resources, start a creative fundraising campaign. If you are a good communicator, you can contact by email, phone, Whats'Up, Messenger people you think would be willing to donate to a cause.

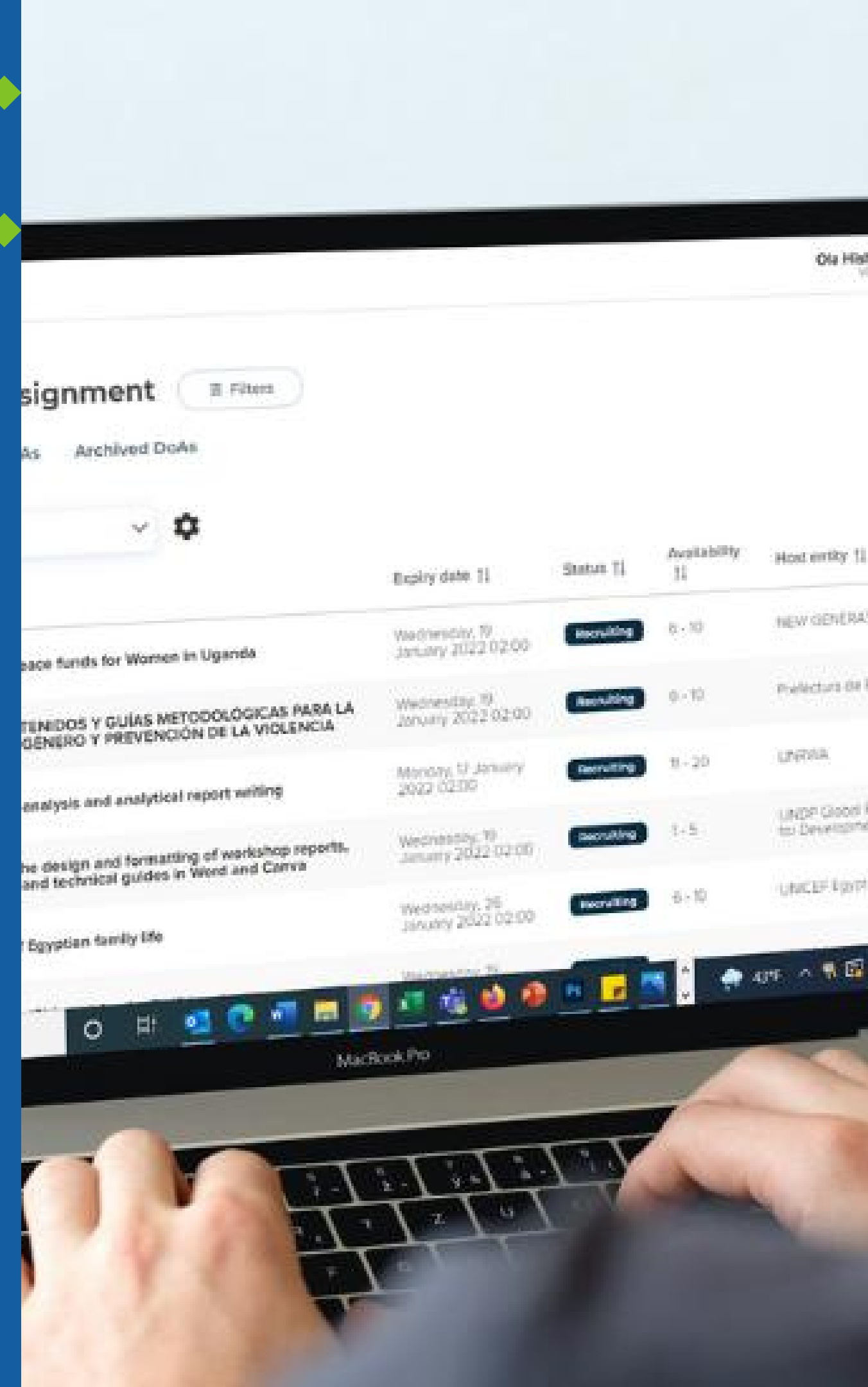
## CROWDFUNDING

if you are familiar with crowdfunding platforms, you can create campaigns that involve mobilising donations from a larger number of people.

## DONATE YOUR ART

if you like sculpting, painting, acting, writing or any form of art that can be promoted online, find a way to get people to donate to your art and redirect donations to a cause or organisation.

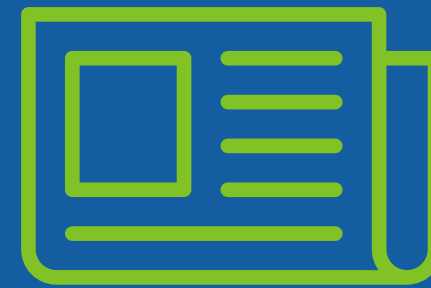


# PR AND DISSEMINATION

if you're looking to take your online volunteering worldwide, this is the place to start. UNV connects you with organizations working for peace and development in need of skills like research, writing, art, and design.

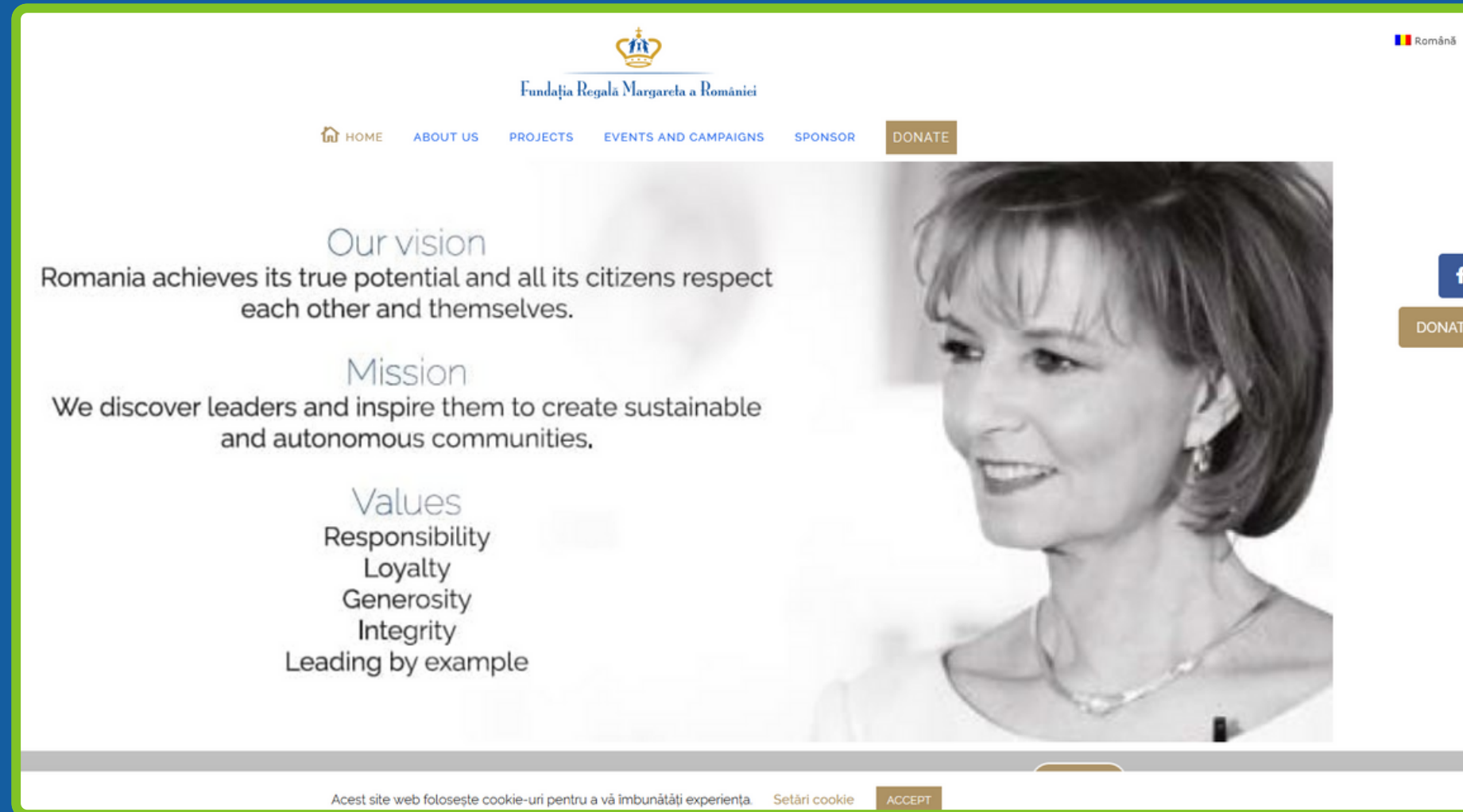

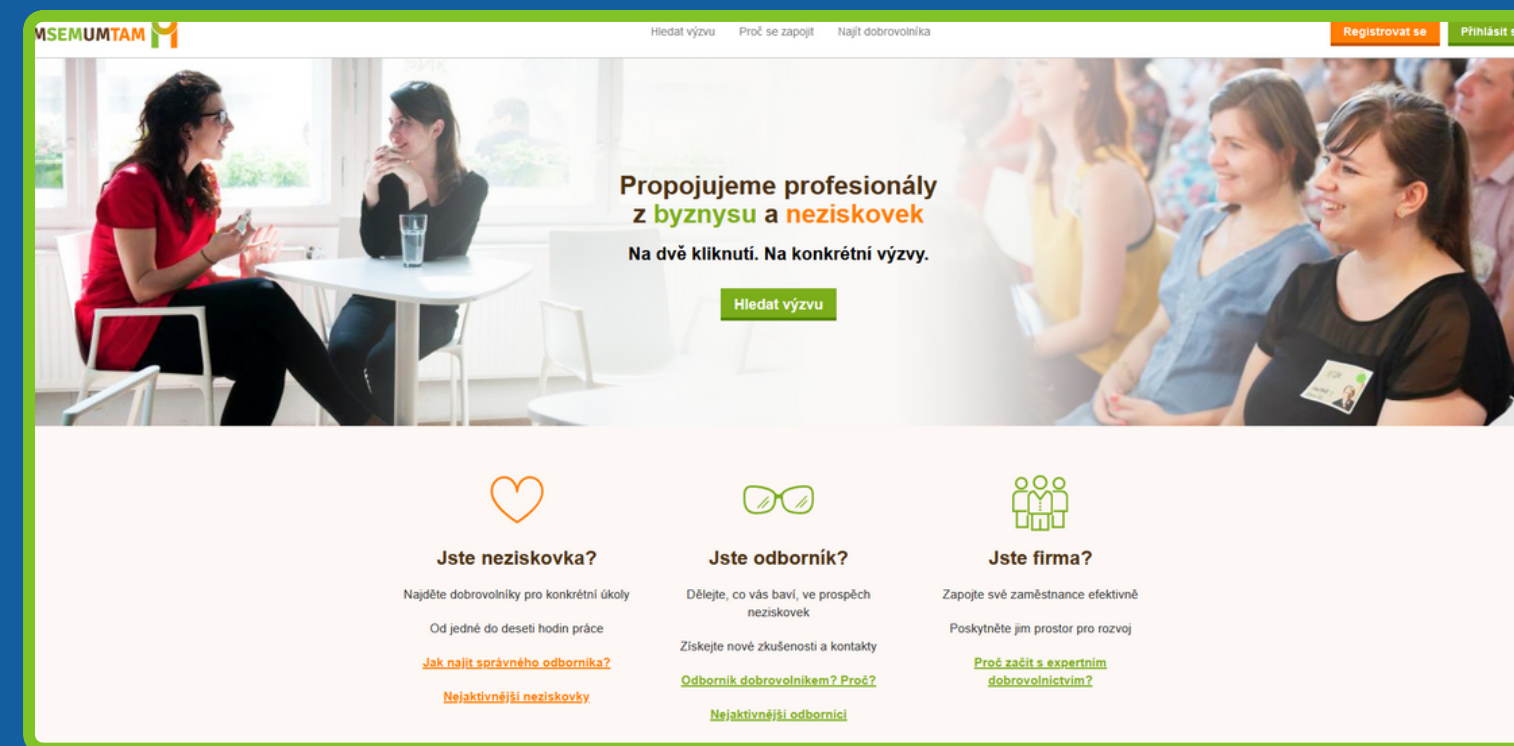
## EXAMPLES FROM CZECH REPUBLIC

# ◆ VOLUNTEER STORIES

I was involved as a digital volunteer in the fundraising campaign - *Changing the world through IMPACT and Service Learning*. I was very motivated to get involved because I strongly believe in the program, I was collecting donations for. It was surprising to see that I was able to mobilize my network of donor friends very well, surpassing the initial amount I had set out to raise.

## ◆ ***What did I do?***

I formulated personalized messages, I found beautiful photos that attracted the attention of friends on social media, I wrote personalized messages on Messenger or WhatsApp to potential donors, I was constant in communication for 30 days. I was very pleased that my digital volunteer contribution managed to support 3 Service-Learning projects implemented by youngsters in 3 communities in Romania. I feel grateful and have a deep sense of meaning for my work that brings positive changes in the lives of many people.

# ◆ VOLUNTEER STORIES

I'm involved as a digital volunteer in a podcast team. Every month we publish an episode on a socio-political topic that is important to our team. My task is to coordinate the entire process, which involves planning our monthly online meetings, inviting interview guests, and ensuring everything is in order with the publication and marketing.

◆ For me, volunteering in a digital format was the best possibility to have on the one side the option to go abroad or to different cities in Germany for internships etc. but at the same time to be able to volunteer consistently in one NGO without the need to look for volunteer options at every place again.

◆ This aligns with the aim of our podcast—to motivate and inspire young people to actively engage in civil society. Many small people doing many small things in many small places can change the face of the world. This is what we want to achieve with our Podcast and the digitalisation made it possible.

# ◆ VOLUNTEER STORIES

It has always been important to me to help other people and to act with civil courage. When I got to know JUUUPORT, I immediately realised that I wanted to help. At JUUUPORT, I know that I can actively make a difference and help children and young people find their way out of a difficult time. That's just great.

◆ JUUUPORT offers first aid online. We give young people the opportunity to turn to us, the scouts, in confidence if they have problems online and get help from us. As a scout at JUUUPORT, I mainly answer enquiries from people seeking advice. But if you are interested in getting involved with JUUUPORT beyond that, you also have the opportunity to do so. For example, I help with our TikTok presence, represent JUUUPORT at events (mainly online events, as I'm from Austria) and am now also a scout mentor. This means that I support new scouts if they have questions about volunteering.

◆ JUUUPORT is mostly online volunteer work. This allows me, as an Austrian, to get involved in such a great project. As some may know from past events, though: Just online is somewhat dull, as you have little social interaction with others, assuming you even know what they look like. That's why JUUUPORT organises scout camps twice a year, where we receive further training on site (usually in Hanover) and, most importantly, meet up in person. That's always great.
